

Advertisement of Stipends

The Heinrich Böll Foundation in cooperation with the Graduate School of Social Sciences (GSSS) at the University of Bremen is offering five doctoral stipends in the following subject area:

Risks of exclusion and strategies of inclusion in expanded Europe

The program promotes dissertation research on exclusion risks in expanded Europe as well on inclusion strategies and their effects. Applications could (but need not) focus on one of the following themes:

- Destandardization of life and work
- Labor migration
- Regional Disparities.

Anchored within the framework of the GSSS, the program offers intensive doctoral supervision and dedicated graduate curricular training both in theory and in qualitative and quantitative methods, embedded in an international context of partner universities. The duration of funding is three years, commencing on 1 October 2005.

The program is open to MA-level graduates from Social Sciences. Applications can be submitted in German or English. Sufficient proficiency in both languages is required.
